THE REFLECTIVE TEACHER'S APPROACH TO THE OUTDOORS AS A PLACE OF EXPLORATION, DISCOVERY AND COLLABORATION

How can we extend our vision of the classroom to include and embrace the possibilities for learning and development in the outdoors? Educators are the gatekeepers to children's experiences. Teachers decide when, how, and why children spend time outdoors. This session examines the connections between teacher theories and actions, as well as the potential constraints and opportunities that influence their decisions. It highlights possibilities for how the outdoor environment, when thoughtfully designed and realized, can attract children's attention as a place for inquiry, exploration, discovery and collaboration. Through three stories of children's experiences in yards at Bing, interacting with both the physical and social environment, the presentation highlights opportunities for meaningful learning and intentional teaching outdoors.
