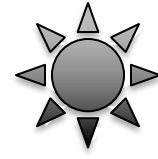




Bing Fair

Committee Descriptions

Advanced Ticket Sales	This team sells tickets in advance to lower the number of people waiting in line the day of the event. Sell in the atrium one to two weeks before the fair. This team will take shifts during drop off and pick up.
Alumni / Photo Booth	Help work the Alumni/Photo Booth. The Photo Booth will be open to only Bing Alumni families from 11:30am – 1pm. Then it will be open to all. This team will work from 11am-3pm.
Bake Sale	Provide well presented, homemade baked goods to the Bing Fair guests to purchase on the day of the Fair. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
Bake Sale Saturday Help	Help on the Saturday before the fair to prepare baked goods for sale the day of the fair. Wrap and price all baked goods. Two hour shifts from 9:30-11am, and 11am-12:30pm.
Baseball Toss	Fun experience for children; use hacky sacks as balls. There are two boards set up in the yard. Free Event. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
Beanbag Toss	Fun experience for children; bean bags are used. There are two boards set up in the yard. Free Event. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
Cake Walk	This team will run the fun, musical game, like musical chairs. This will run several times during the fair. There are 24 spaces for children. When the music stops, a number is pulled. The child on the number wins the cake. All other children will get cupcakes. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
Challenge Course	Children safely maneuver the challenge course and gain confidence in their climbing ability. This course will be set up by the teachers. Teachers will also be present. This team will help children, and pass out prizes at the end – a Challenge Course Ribbon. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
Cookie Painting	Decoration of cookies by the children. Approximately 600 cookies are purchased, with food coloring and sprinkles. This team passes out cookies to children/parents, and replenishes food coloring and sprinkles for the children to use. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
Duck Pond	Children get to try and try again to find the duck with the “X”. A prize will be given. Two water tables are set up for the children. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
Easel Painting	Children experience brushes and colors. Volunteers restock the paint and brushes. Encourage parents to buy a Bing Frame. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.

Face Painting/Art	Fun with face painting and art. Children can select a tattoo or request a drawing on face, arms or hand. Choose from set pictures. Volunteers do the painting, and help provide assistance/cleaning. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
Finance/Ticket Sales	This team works the day of the fair selling tickets for entrance to the fair. They also help bundle the tickets ahead of time in bundles of 10, 20 and 40 tickets. Each ticket is \$.50. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
Fishing Pond	Children fish from the bridge in the West Yard. Practice aiming rod, and "fishing". Rods are provided to catch magnetic fish. Two pools are set up. A prize is given to each child. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
Frozen Fruit Juice Bar	Sell Dryers All-Fruit Frozen Bars. \$1.00 per bar. Drinks will also be sold at this booth. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
Fun with Musical Instruments	Children have fun experimenting and playing with a variety of musical instruments, including rhythm sticks, shakers, drums, xylophones and triangles. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
Handprints	Great keepsake for parents and fun for the children! Children will use red and blue paint to add their handprints to white cardstock paper with a preprinted poem on it. Volunteers will help with the process and clean up. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
International American Foods	This team will sell International/American foods at the Bing Fair. Some prep will begin a few weeks before. Pans will be distributed in the atrium. Parents donate food, and we solicit donations from local vendors. This booth will also sell drinks. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
Intl/American Foods Kitchen Help	This team will work with the International/American Foods team and will heat, prepare and deliver food out to the booth on the Center Patio. Check off food items as they arrive, using a master list. Look for common allergens, and make sure all foods are labeled. Shifts the day of the fair are 10:30am-12:00pm, 12:00pm-1:30pm, and 1:30-3:15pm.
Intl/American Foods Runners Team	This team will pick up food donations from local vendors. Coordinate with chair on pickup days/times. This team will work from the Friday before the Fair, to the morning of the Fair.
Pizza Booth	Sell pizza to fair guests. Pizza will be delivered on a regular schedule throughout the day of the fair. Cheese and Pepperoni pizza only. This booth also sells watermelon and drinks. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
Pocket Person	Spread sunshine with a smiling face and "prizes". The Pocket Person walks around the day of the fair with prizes in their pockets. Children give one ticket to pick their prize out of whatever pocket they'd like. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.

Sand Castles	Play and create with sand! Sand molds, buckets, shovels and water are provided to children. Teachers will be involved to encourage play and involvement. Volunteers help to make sure children are playing safe. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
Saturday Set Up	Set up supplies and tables on the Saturday before the Fair in preparation for Sunday. Move all drinks to rooms, boxes to staging areas, cover all tables, place recycling bins and trash bins throughout the yard. Bury Scavenger Hunt prizes. This team works on the Saturday before the fair from 9:30am until approx. 12:30pm.
Scavenger Hunt	Fun Treasure Hunting for all children. All buried treasure will be buried on Saturday, but this team may need to replenish. Volunteer hands out shovel, and encourages treasure hunting. Tickets required. Children dig until they find their prize (one per dig). Children love the large dinosaurs! This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
Spirit Shop	This team helps sell Bing branded logo apparel. Includes t-shirts, shorts, hoodies, hats, frames, tote bags, books and cd's. Bing staff will also help in this booth. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
Sunday Clean Up	This team helps get the school ready for classes the next day. Clean all areas of the fair, including signs, materials, trash, tables, and chairs. All Bing staff also help. This team works from 3-4pm on the day of the fair.
Sunday Set Up	This team helps set up the fair on Sunday morning, with assistance from the Bing staff. Help set up all activities, help cut watermelon for the Pizza Booth, add ice to all drink buckets, help International/American and Bake Sale booths with set up, help clean up at the Alumni Breakfast. This team works on the day of the fair from 10:00am – 11:30am.
Treasure Bags	Children create a personalized bag for collecting their prizes and cookies. They decorate with markers and stickers. Expect to hand out approximately 500 bags to children attending the Fair. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
Volunteer Check In	This team helps systemically check in all 200+ volunteers the morning of the fair. Sign in table is at the entrance, in the West Yard. Check off name on list as volunteers check in. Pass out map to volunteers and direct to their placement. Place extra volunteers where needed. A Bing staff member will also help at booth. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
Water Works	Children have fun with water, learning how to pour, and how water flows. Teachers will set up this activity. Volunteers to make sure children are playing safe. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
Wood Gluing	Children create their very own object with glue and wood. Children use brushes to apply the glue. Volunteers help restock glue and brushes. This team works on the day of the fair in one hour shifts from 11am-3pm.
